SELX Market Report Weaner Sale - 6th April 2018

Total Yarding: 3,634

Numbers were similar to the last weaner sale a few weeks ago. Most of the weaners were presented in good store condition and there was more weight throughout the sale. Solid competition came from southern buyers along with a few local Restockers. Steers were \$60 to \$70/head cheaper on average while heifers were steady.

Light weaner steers under 200kg sold to \$650/head. Medium weights which were best supplied sold from \$595 to \$875 and steers 280-330kg reached \$970/head. The few over 330/kg in weight that returned to the paddock reached \$1,025 and the best price paid was \$1,145/head for steers into a feedlot. Most of the steers averaged 290c to 320c/kg.

Almost 1500 heifers were penned and medium weights sold from \$500 to \$775 to average \$625/head. Heavy weights sold to \$760/head and most of the heifers averaged 250c to 270c/kg.
