SELX Market Report Prime Sheep & Lamb – 17th October 2018

Total Yarding: 20,183

Lamb numbers were back and included 5,900 new season lambs. The quality was good with plenty of store lambs and a good run of trade weights. Heavy new season lambs were limited and there was a large draft of Merino lambs. All the usual buyers and a few extra buyers were operating in a dearer market.

New season lambs to restock sold from \$98 to \$136 with feeder paying to \$148/head. Medium and heavy trade lambs were \$10 to \$15 dearer and ranged from \$144 to \$170/head. Heavy lambs were \$5 to \$6 better ranging from \$170 to \$196 and extra heavy lambs reached \$225/head and averaging around 750c/kg cwt.

Heavy weight old lambs were \$8 dearer selling to \$158 with extra heavy weights to \$173/head. Merino lambs sold from \$118 to \$146/head averaging 650c/kg.

Mutton numbers jumped and the quality was good. Most fell into the light and medium weight range and prices were \$6 to \$12/head dearer. Medium weights sold from \$82 to \$120/head. Heavy crossbred ewes ranged between \$112 and \$160/head. Merino wethers reached \$156/head. Most of the medium and heavy mutton averaged 460c to 490c/kg cwt.
