## SELX Market Report <br> Prime Cattle - 28 May 2020

## Total Yarding: 471

Numbers declined and the quality of the young cattle continues to be good, while the grown 2 and 4 tooth cattle quality is easing. Prime grown steers were very limited and there was a good line up of heavy cows. Restockers were again the major buyers of cattle pushing prices higher.

Weaner steers sold from 448c to 466c, lifting $15 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Weaner heifers sold to $415 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ on a limited supply. Yearling steers lifted 15 c to 20c with restocking orders paying from 390c to 433c/kg. Feeders made from 372c to 410c and processors sold from 375 c to $420 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Light and medium weight heifers were 6c stronger, making from 372c to $408 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$.

Grown steers to restock and feed sold from 300 c to $372 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Very heavy bullocks to process sold to $325 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Grown heifers to process lifted 10c selling from 276 c to $368 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ for prime 2 tooths. Restocking cows lifted 10c to 15 c selling from 280c to $306 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ for cows that had been running with a bull. Heavy cows were $6 c$ to $8 c$ dearer selling from $272 c$ to $310 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$.
