SELX Market Report Prime Sheep & Lamb – 3 February 2021

Total Yarding: 14,044

Lamb numbers increased and the quality was a little plainer. There was a good selection of lambs in all weight and condition categories. There was a very good run of heavy shorn lambs and a lot of light store lambs suited to the restocker. The market sold to a firm to dearer trend with the neatly shorn lambs attracting a premium.

Restocking lambs were \$9 dearer selling from \$112 to \$172/head to return to the paddock. Trade lambs were firm for the medium and heavy weights making from \$175 to \$186/head to average from 850c to 880c/kg cwt. The heavy lambs lifted \$2 to \$5 selling from \$186 to \$222 or 825c to 840c/kg cwt on average and extra heavy lambs sold from \$233 to \$256/head. The best of the hoggets reached a top of \$248/head.

Mutton numbers jumped and the quality was mixed. Prices were much stronger rising as much as \$20/head in places. Medium weight ewes sold from \$123 to \$168/head. Heavy crossbred ewes made from \$186 to \$230 and Merino wethers reached \$214/head.
