## SELX Market Report Prime Sheep & Lamb – 31 March 2021

Total Yarding: 3,674

Lamb numbers lifted and the quality was mixed. There were a few lambs that were lacking the desired finish along with reasonable numbers of well finished trade and heavy weight lambs. Extra heavy lambs were in fewer numbers and there was a sprinkling of light shorn store lambs that sold to strong competition. Feeders were active on the trade weighted lambs. The market sold to a cheaper trend very much quality driven.

Light store lambs were dearer with the shorn lambs \$130 to \$180/head and feeders paid to \$182 for lambs with more skin. Medium and heavy trade lambs were \$2 to \$7 cheaper \$169 to \$178/head or 800c to 810c/kg cwt. Heavy lambs 22 to 26kg were firm to \$3 cheaper and the best supplied lambs and ranged from \$187 to \$205/head to average 770c/kg cwt. The 26kg and heavier ranged from \$192 to \$226/head. The best of the very heavy hoggets reached \$240/head.

Mutton numbers lifted and the quality was good. Medium weight ewes were best supplied and prices were dearer. Medium weight ewes sold from \$126/head for the lighter 2 scores to \$188 for 3 score longed skinned Merinos. Heavy crossbred ewes \$200 to \$225/head and Merino wethers reached \$210/head. Carcase prices averaged between 640c and 680c/kg with some of the better covered and shaped pushing over 700c/kg cwt.
