

SELX Market Report

Prime Sheep & Lamb – 19 May 2021

Total Yarding: 10,127

Lamb numbers lifted and the quality was a little mixed. There were some good trade and heavy lambs alongside some lambs that lacked some finish. Lamb feeders were keen on the secondary lambs and a similar number of restockers went hard on the heavy lambs. The market trend was firm to \$4 dearer.

Restocking lambs \$67 to \$148/head. Heavier weights returning to the paddock and feed reached \$201/head. Trade lambs to 24kg cwt were firm selling from \$164 to \$204/head and averaged 795c to 830c/kg cwt. Lambs 24 to 26kg gained \$4 and ranged from \$198 to \$212/head or 770c to 790c/kg cwt. Heavy lambs estimated 26 to 30kg cwt were firm \$204 to \$211 or 750c/kg cwt on average. Extra heavy lambs over 30kg cwt reached \$246/head. Merino lambs were \$4 to \$6 dearer on the trade weights \$154 to \$167/head. Best priced hogget reached \$236/head.

Mutton numbers slipped and the quality was mixed with most weights and grades penned. Prices remained similar. Medium weight ewes \$125 to woolly Merinos at \$175/head. Heavy crossbred ewes \$204 to \$230/head and Merinos \$188 to \$225/head. Heavy wethers reached \$238/head. Most averaged 620c to 650c/kg cwt.
