**SELX Market Report
Prime Sheep & Lamb – 23 June 2021**

Total Yarding: 11,823

Lamb numbers lifted and the quality improved. Heavy lambs were again best supplied, while trade weights were limited. There were a few pens of light new season trade lambs and a sprinkling of Merinos. The better lambs were dearer while the lighter secondary lambs eased.

Light new season trade lambs reached \$160 with heavier weights making \$203/head. Old light score 2 processing lambs made from \$112 to \$147/head. Trade lambs weighing up to 24kg ranged from \$174 to \$201/head, to average 780c to 810c/kg cwt. The 24 to 26kg lambs were \$4 dearer, making from \$196 to \$213/head, averaging 780c/kg cwt. Trade merinos sold from \$161 to \$186/head to average 700c to 720c/kg cwt.

The 26 to 30kg lambs were the biggest movers, up \$7 to range from \$198 to \$247/head or 765c/kg cwt. Extra heavy lambs reached \$259/head.

Mutton numbers lifted and quality was mixed. Most mutton sold \$6 to \$10/head dearer. Medium weight ewes sold from \$144 to \$147, while heavy crossbred ewes made from \$220 to \$238/head. Merinos reached a top of \$239/head. First cross ewe lambs to a restocker reached \$270/head.
