**SELX Market Report  
Prime Sheep & Lamb – 30 June 2021**

**Total Yarding: 8,107**

Lamb numbers eased and the quality was a little plainer. There were some well-presented trade and heavy lambs but in the smaller yarding secondary lambs were more evident. There was a small offering of Merino lambs. Not all the usual buyers were operating in a dearer market.

The light score 2 processing lambs made from \$124 to \$150/head. Trade lambs were \$2 to \$4 dearer selling from \$172 to \$207/head or 800c to 840c/kg cwt. Lambs 24 to 26kg lifted \$7 and ranged from \$202 to \$217/head. Heavy lambs weighing 26 to 30kg gained \$2 and sold from \$204 to \$234/head. Extra heavy weights over 30kg, made from \$236 to \$274, lifting \$3/head. Merino trades sold from \$143 to \$171 and the best priced hogget reached \$208/head.

Mutton numbers also eased and quality was fair to good. There was a selection of weights and light sheep were in demand while the heavy mutton had a softer buying group. Prices were firm to \$3/head cheaper. Medium weight ewes sold from \$145 to \$171/head. Heavy crossbred ewes made from \$178 to \$232 and Heavy Merinos reached \$223/head.
