**SELX Market Report  
Prime Sheep & Lamb – 14 July 2021**

**Total Yarding: 13,072**

Lamb numbers increased and the quality was improved. There was a limited run of trade weights, while heavy lambs and extra heavy weights coming off crop were better supplied. The biggest increase was in old heavy lamb and there were a few more light Merinos. New season lambs remain limited. The market sold to a dearer trend.

Old score 2 processing lambs made from \$146 to \$169/head. Trade weights to 24kg were \$4 to \$7 dearer selling from \$177 to \$223/head averaging 860c to 890c/kg cwt. The 24 to 26kg lambs gained \$10 and sold from \$204 to \$247/head. Heavy lambs weighing 26 to 30kg lifted \$15 and were the best supplied, making from \$231 to \$268/head. Extra heavy weights ranged from \$262 to \$284/head. Merino trades lost \$6 on average to make from \$153 to \$178 and heavy weights ranged from \$180 to \$216/head. Hogget reached a top of \$238/head.

Mutton numbers increased and the quality was mixed. Medium and heavy weights were well supplied with light sheep limited. Prices were dearer by \$5 on most of the medium weights and up to \$20/head dearer on a better run of heavy mutton. Medium weight ewes made from \$134 to \$189/head. Heavy crossbred ewes sold from \$230 to \$260 and heavy Merinos sold to a top of \$206/head. Merino wethers sold to \$230/head.
