



SELX Market Report

Prime Sheep & Lamb – 4 August 2021

Total Yarding: 9100

Lamb numbers lifted for a mixed quality yarding. Trade and heavy old lambs were well supplied but there was a bigger influence of secondary lambs that lacked weight and finish. There was a large run of Merino lambs and the market sold to a cheaper trend with the better lambs \$10 to \$15 cheaper and the secondary lambs \$20/head and more in places.

The score 2 processing lambs sold from \$117 to \$144/head. Trade weights to 24kg cwt ranged from \$163 to \$220, while the 24 to 26kg cwt lambs sold from \$210 to \$247/head averaging 860c/kg cwt. Heavy 26 to 30kg cwt lambs ranged from \$230 to \$269 and extra heavy lambs made from \$276 to \$320/head. Heavy Merino lambs sold from \$216 to \$227/head or 780c to 800c/kg cwt.

Mutton numbers were steady and the quality also slipped with prices \$4 to \$8/head cheaper. Medium weight ewes made from \$136 to \$180/head. Heavy crossbred ewes sold from \$198 to \$264 and Merino ewes reached \$223/head.
