



SELX Market Report

Prime Sheep & Lamb – 18 August 2021

Total Yarding: 5667

Lamb numbers eased and there were 1,500 new season lambs offered. The quality of the new season lambs was fair to good with a small run of store lambs, the majority of which were medium and heavy trades. Old lambs varied with a few good heavy and extra heavy weights alongside secondary trade lambs. The market trend was dearer.

New season trade lambs lifted \$15 and ranged from \$205 to \$231, while heavy weights reached \$260/head. Light store lambs ranged between \$135 and \$180/head.

Old trade lambs were \$20 dearer with trade weights to 24kg selling from \$194 to \$239/head to average 950c to 975c/kg cwt. Heavy lambs ranged from \$240 to \$290 and the few extra heavy lambs made from \$300 to \$320/head. Merino trade lambs were dearer with not the cover of previous weeks, selling from \$175 to \$227 and heavy weights reached \$255/head.

Mutton numbers eased and the quality was mixed, however prices were mostly dearer by \$10/head. Medium weight ewes made from \$123 to \$178/head. Heavy crossbred ewes sold from \$190 to \$248 and Merinos reached \$247/head, with most averaging between 640c and 670c/kg cwt.
