



SELX Market Report

Prime Lamb & Sheep – 26 July 2023

Total Yarding: 10,790

Lamb numbers were similar and the quality was again plain. Most lambs were lacking condition and weight and were in 2 score condition. Trade lambs were well supplied and there were only a few heavy and extra heavy weights offered. Restocking interest was very quiet. The market fell around \$15 to \$20/head on the better end of the trade lambs, secondary lambs were back \$30 to \$35/head.

The 2 score processing lambs to 18kg cwt sold from \$25 to \$70/head. The trade weights 20 to 22kg \$67 to \$97 and the 22 to 24kg lambs \$71 to \$114/head averaging 445c/kg for the better lines and 300c to 350c/kg for the secondary lambs. Heavy lambs sold from \$101 to \$140/head to ranged between 390c and 435c/kg cwt. The best of the heavy hoggets reached \$88/head.

Mutton numbers eased and the quality remains plain with a lot of 1 and 2 score ewes penned. Prices fell \$30 to \$40/head. Light ewes \$15 to \$38 and medium weights \$42 to \$68/head. Heavy crossbred ewes sold from \$61 to \$74 and Merino wethers reached \$89/head. Most averaging between 200c and 240c/kg cwt.
