



SELX Market Report

Prime Lamb & Sheep – 13 September 2023

Total Yarding: 5486

Lamb numbers lifted and the quality still remains mixed with a large percentage of lambs lacking the desired finish. There were around 250 new season lambs offered and there were several pens of medium and heavy trade weights in very good order. Not all the usual buyers attended and the new season lambs sold to solid demand while old lambs were an average of \$10/head cheaper.

New season trade lambs sold from \$102 to \$115 and heavy weights reached \$121/head averaging 470c to 480c/kg cwt. Old 2 score processing lambs to 18kg cwt ranged from \$24 to \$48/head and the 24 to 26kg lambs \$64 to \$93/head. There was an order for heavy weights lambs which sold from \$88 to \$130/head. The best of the hoggets reached \$60/head.

Mutton numbers eased and the medium weight run of mutton was \$2 to \$3 cheaper selling from \$20 to \$29/head and the heavy crossbred ewes were slightly stronger selling between \$29 and \$42/head.
