

SELX Market Report

Special Weaner Cattle – 12 April 2024

Total Yarding: 6,202

Numbers increased and the quality improved with a fresher run of weaners. There were mostly medium and heavy weights offered with only a small tail of light weights. Angus and Angus cross weaners made up over 95 percent of the offering with a sprinkle of British bred cattle and a few Euro crosses. Compared to the last weaner sale Angus steers were firm and heifers lifted \$30 to \$50/head. The other breeds lifted between \$80 and \$140/head but numbers were limited and the quality better.

Medium weight Angus weaners to 280kg sold from \$750 to \$1370/head and most averaged around 400c/kg, the British breed averaged 350c to 380c/kg. Heavy weights weighing 381kg reached \$1490/head or 391c/kg. Medium weight heifers sold between \$625 and \$935/head to average 320c and the best of the heavy weights reached \$1020/head or 292c/kg for 349kg.
