



RLX Market Report

SELX Prime Sheep and Lamb Sale – Wednesday 21st August 2024

Total Yarding: 6515 (+152) | Sheep Yarding: 1800 (-1400) | Lamb Yarding: 4715 (+1552)

Lamb numbers eased and the quality was mixed. There were a few new season lambs that included a run of store lambs. There also was a very good run of trade and heavy lambs with a short jacket but most of the yarding was lambs with longer dry skins or secondary lambs. The market sold to stronger trends with the better lambs up \$8 to \$10 and long skins were firm to \$4 dearer. The light and secondary trades gained \$4 to \$5/head.

The run of store new season lambs sold from \$81 to \$132/head and the best of the trade weights reached \$218/head or 855c/kg.

Old 2 score processing lambs to 18kg ranged from \$76 to \$138/head. The trade weights 20 to 24kg ranged from \$124 to \$196/head with the better end averaging 760c to 820c/kg cwt. Heavy weights ranged from \$170 to \$232 and extra heavy lambs reached \$235/head and ranged from 750c to 815c/kg. Trade Merinos reached \$189/head.
